The Guest speaker is Mark Whitacre

Mark Whitacre is an IVY League Ph.D, and the highest-ranked executive of any Fortune 500 company to become a whistleblower in U.S. history and is responsible for uncovering the ADM price-fixing scandal in the early 1990's. His undercover work with the FBI during the ADM scandal was the inspiration for the major motion picture, "The Informant," starring Matt Damon as Mark Whitacre. The ADM case landed Mark in federal prison for fraud tax evasion.

Drawing from his unique history, Mark provides one-of-a-kind insight into corporate ethics, corporate greed, and the warning signs of a flawed corporate leadership. As Mr. Douglas Burris, Chief of U.S. Federal Probation in the Eastern District of Missouri has stated publicly "The story about Mark Whitacre's redemption and second chance is one of the most inspirational stories of our time."

Since December of 2006, he has been the Chief Operating Officer (COO) and Chief Science Officer at Cypress Systems, Inc. Dr. Whitacre and his wife Ginger, have been married for 35 years and have three grown children. Ginger has been the 'super glue' who held their family together through the years when Mark was a busy Cornell Ph.D. student, to the time Mark spent in federal incarceration.
