96th Kiwanis International Convention in Geneva, Switzerland: Opening Session, NJ District Caucus, Business Session and Closing Session July 7-10, 2011

Opening Session: 2-4pm on Thursday July 7th at Palexpo Convention Hall

UNICEF and Kiwanis International are working together on Project Eliminate www.TheEliminateProject.org Jane Goodall gave a presentation on a 'Reason for Hope and the Way Ahead'. Jane gave us information on the background of her work in Africa with the chimpanzees. She broke it down into 3 parts: helping animals, helping the environment and helping the human community. The key to making this work are the young people of today who have energy, courage and commitment.
